

INVITATION for competent authorities

Online-training available on using the router database for competent authorities and database manager of organic seed databases

In the framework of the Horizon 2020 funded LIVESEED project, FiBL-Germany developed the EU-wide router database for organic seeds which will allow seed supplier and supplier for plant reproductive material to offer their organic propagated seeds and planting material to all EU-member states as well as Switzerland and UK from one single platform. National authorities and database manager will receive a login to the platform to check the offers that are listed for their countries. When accepted the offers will appear in the national databases for organic seeds. The platform can be found under www.seeds4organic.eu.

For all interested authorities and database managers there will be an online-training on how to use the database. All relevant functions as well as additional background information about the router database and the LIVESEED project will be discussed during this training. The training will take place online on

26th April from 2-4pm in English.
